

Sorus Tissue Quality Grading



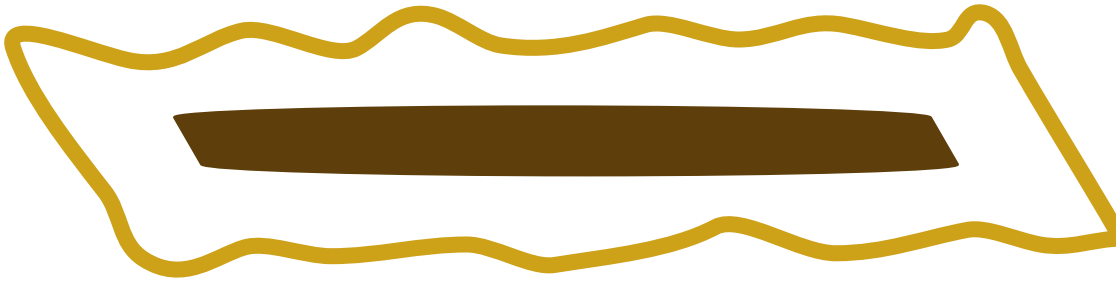
Fouling/Epiphytes



Fouling, like other algae and bryozoans, is attached to the blade's surface and can cause contamination issues in your tanks.

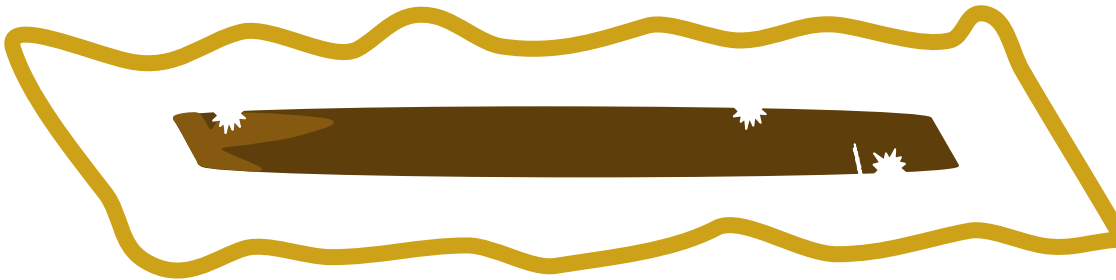
Sorus Quality

Sorus that is spent, or has already released spores, appears lighter in color and should not be added to your release.



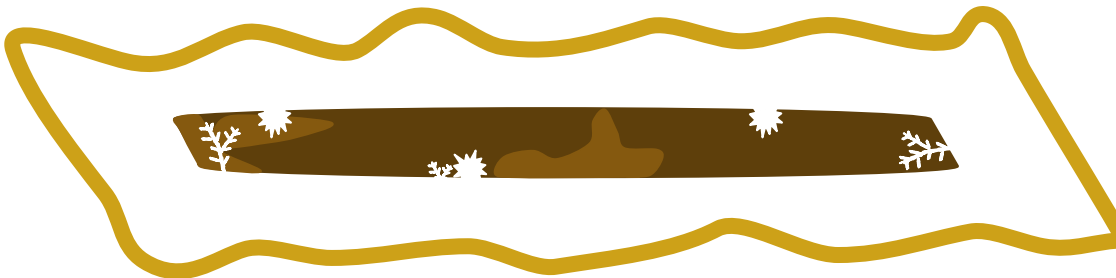
Very High

Keep all of this sorus if both sides are clean and all of the sorus appears dark brown.



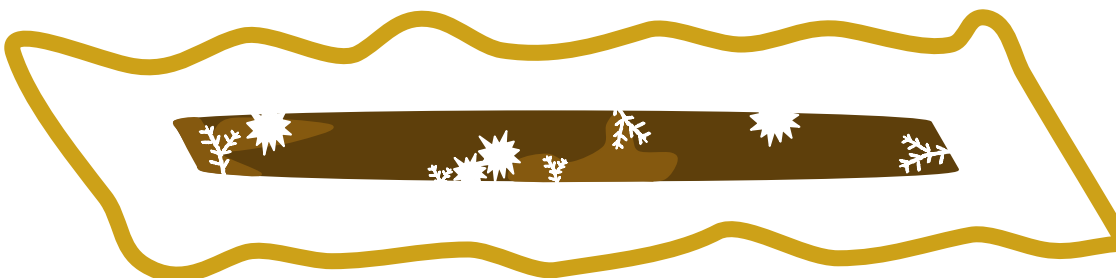
High

Cut out the parts of the sorus that have any scrapes, fouling, or is spent and use the rest. You will likely use 50-90% of the sorus.



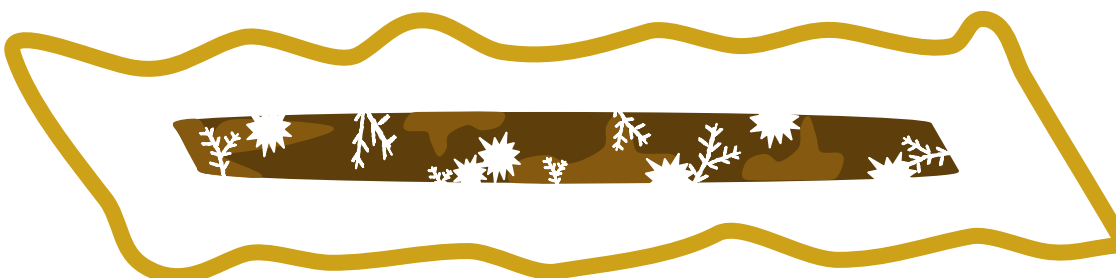
Low

Only use the sections of sorus that have no fouling and are good quality. You will likely use 30-50% of the sorus.



Very Low

Only use the small sections of the sorus that have no fouling and are good quality. You will likely only use 10-20% of the sorus.



Bad

Do not use this sorus.
